*To read these words students will need to know the [phonograms](#) **ng** and **er**, the second sounds of **c** and **e**, and the [spelling rules](#):

- A E O U usually say their long sounds at the end of the syllable.
- Any vowel may say one of the schwa sounds, /ǘ/ or /i/, in an unstressed syllable or unstressed word.
- Silent final E rule: English words do not end in V or U.
