*To read these words students will need to know the [phonogram ar](#), the second sounds of **y**, **s**, **o**, and **c**, and the [spelling rules](#):

- A E O U usually say their long sounds at the end of the syllable.
- The vowel says its long sound because of the E.
- C always softens to /s/ when followed by E, I, or Y. Otherwise, C says /k/.
- Any vowel may say one of the schwa sounds, /ǘ/ or /i/, in an unstressed syllable or unstressed word.
